CODEX MINISTRIES TRIP: October 13 - 25

Stan Tinon is returning to Cuba to teach in two locations. He will continue teaching the on-going seminario in Camajuani (rural central Cuba) and will be launching a new seminario in Remedios. A "seminario" is several days of intensive classes covering two or more courses designed to equip pastors and church leaders with Bible college level training. This kind of training is unavailable in this anti-Christian Communist nation. In addition to Stan's travel expenses, CODEX Ministries must raise the funds for all seminario expenses, including transporting, housing and feeding the students and providing Spanish Study Bibles and Bible dictionaries to which Cuban church leaders have no access. Both Camajunai and Remedios are suffering from Hurricane Irma. Remedios, only 2 miles from the north coast of Cuba, was hit hard for hours. CODEX has established a "Hurricane Relief Fund", every dollar of which will be taken to Cuba to help the churches with restoration.
