RE-ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS: *This is for those who have already enrolled before and have registered your Kroger Plus Card and EMAIL account.*

- Go to www.kroger.com and “Sign-In” using your email address and password.
- Click on “My Account” & then Select “Account Settings”
- Go to “Community Rewards:
- Find Your Organization by entering First Presbyterian Church’s Account Number: **80895**
- Check “First Presbyterian Church of Pataskala”
- And then finish by clicking on “SAVE”
- Go back to “My Account” and notice the update in the bottom right-hand corner under Community Rewards. You should see our church name and date of renewal.

1st Time ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS: *This is for those of you who have NOT enrolled before. You will need access to a home computer and have a Kroger Rewards Card.*

- Go to www.kroger.com and click on “Create an Account” and in 3 easy steps you can create your new account.
- Provide your email address and create a password; provide your Kroger Plus Card Number or Alternate ID (the phone number linked to your Plus Card); and your 5 digit ZIP code.
- After you have confirmed your new Account, follow the steps above in “Re-Enrolling” to enroll your Kroger Plus Card in the Community Rewards Program.
