Maundy Thursday Communion and Service of Tenebrae March 29, 2018

A Service of Tenebrae is a time to reflect upon the emotions of the Passion narrative. "Tenebrae" is Latin for "shadows" or "darkness" and has been practiced by the church, beginning with the Monastic orders, since medieval times. As the passion unfolds, the darkness or shadows increase until only the Christ candled remains lit. Once it is removed, feel free to remain in the darkened sanctuary for as long as you desire, then depart in silence.
