

# CODEX MINISTRIES TRIP: October 31 – November 9, 2018



Stan Tinon is returning to Cuba to teach in two locations. Jim Boggs and Todd Garman will be joining the teaching team this trip. They will continue teaching the on-going seminarios in both Camajuani (rural central Cuba) and in Havana. A “seminario” is several days of intensive classes covering two or more courses designed to equip pastors and church leaders with Bible college level training. This kind of training is unavailable in this Communist nation.

In addition to Stan’s travel expenses, CODEX Ministries must raise the funds for ALL seminario expenses in both places.

These include:

transporting, housing and feeding the students and the team, as well as providing Spanish Study Bibles and Bible dictionaries to which Cuban church leaders have no access. We are also collecting specific items requested by our Cuban friends this trip.

Financial gifts can be given through First Presbyterian Church and will be passed on to CODEX anonymously.

- ❖ antibiotic & hydrocortisone cream/ointment
- ❖ pain relievers (adult & children’s Tylenol, ibuprofen, low-dose aspirin, naproxen sodium)
- ❖ vitamins (especially children’s & pre-natal)

- men’s rubber farm boots, size 8 (good quality)
- hot melt glue gun and glue sticks
- bicycle inner tube patching kits
- bicycle tires (not inner tubes) for street use: 26” diameter, minimum 1.75” maximum 2.0”
- flexible marker boards (dry erase surface that rolls up)
- a volleyball
- raisins (must be in a sealed box/package)
