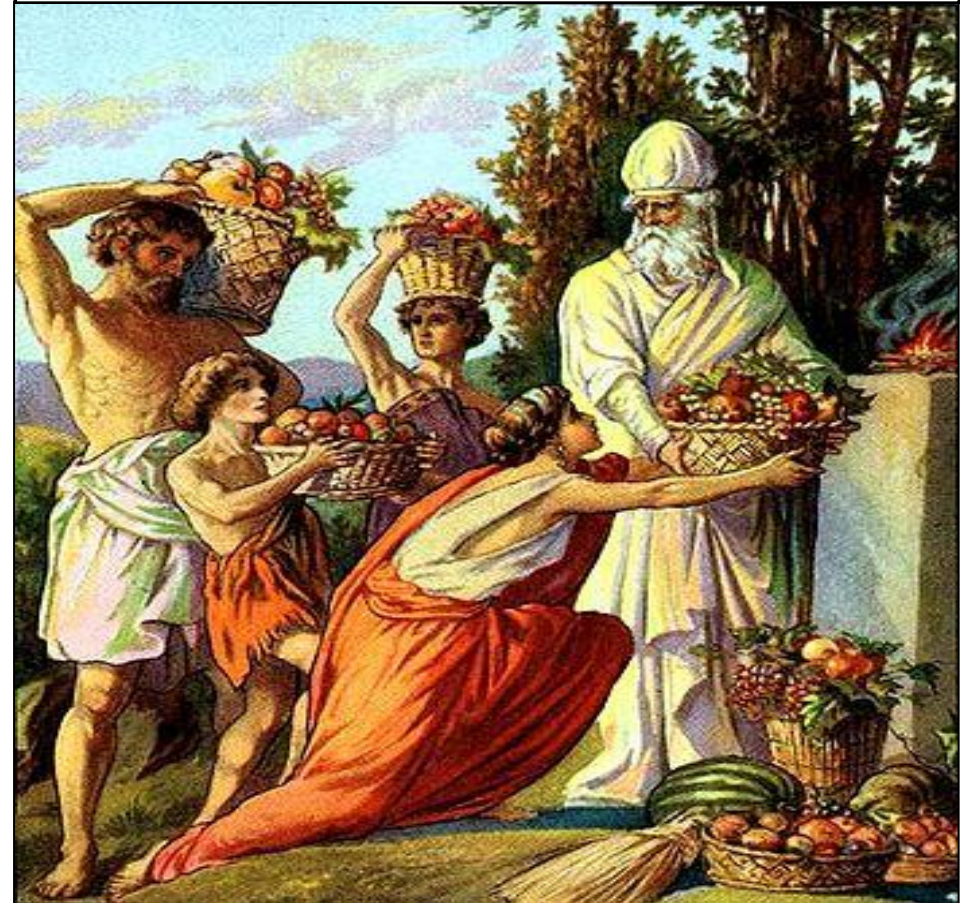

UPDATE ON SYDNEY: She had her brain aneurysm surgery on Tues., Jan. 22nd. The Surgery went well, with only a minor set-back the following day with a post-operative, low-grade fever and headache. As this insert is being written, she is doing much better. However, there are future obstacles, as this was an experimental surgery for a child. It has only been done on Adults, as only 3% of children in the U.S. have brain aneurysms. Her surgery was a tunneling surgery that happened through the groin. Because it's considered experimental, insurance will not cover the cost. She will go back in 6 months to see if it has worked, plus a change in life-style and have to take blood-thinners for the rest of her life.
