**Call to Worship:** Psalm 148 *Responsively*

*Praise the Lord.*

**Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise him in the heights above.**

**Prayer of Confession:** Colossians 3:5-8 (*in unison*): Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to [our] earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these the wrath of God is coming. [We] used to walk in these ways. In the life [we] once lived. But now [we] must also rid [our]selves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from [our] lips. Hear our prayers of confession, Lord. (*Pause in silent confession.*)

**Assurance of Forgiveness:** Colossians 1:21-23 (*responsively*):

*Once [we] were alienated from God and were enemies in [our] minds because of [our] evil behavior.*

But now he has reconciled [us] by Christ’s physical body through death to present [us] holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation – if [we] continue in [our] faith established

and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that [we] heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven!

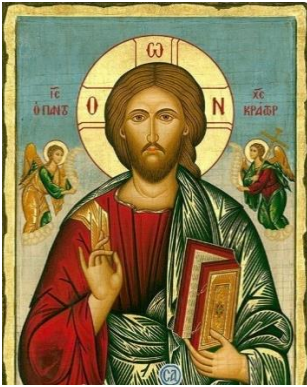
